**RESOLUTION OF THE LEMON GROVE CITY COUNCIL REVISING THE APPROPRIATIONS
LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEARS 2009-2010 AND 2010-2011**

WHEREAS, Constitutional Article XIII-B (Propositions 4 and 111) places an appropriations limitation on State and Local Government; and

WHEREAS, his appropriations limitation is based on proceeds of taxes adjusted annually from the base year 1986-87 by either the population growth factor for the City of Lemon Grove or for the County of San Diego, and by either the change in the California Per Capita Personal Income or the change in Non-Residential Construction for the City of Lemon Grove; and

WHEREAS, the City has received inflation and population data from the State Department of Finance to calculate the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Appropriations Limit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lemon Grove wishes to select those options providing the greatest rate of change as shown below:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Lemon Grove, California establishes the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Appropriations Limit at \$35,900,624, and the Fiscal Year 2010-2011 Appropriations Limit at \$35,509,307.
