LEMON GROVE – In an abundance of caution and concern for the safety and well-being of the Lemon Grove community, non-essential meetings or gathers that fall within the guidance of the State, will be postponed or cancelled.

The California Department of Public Health is stating large gatherings that include 250 people or more and smaller gatherings held in venues that do not allow for social distancing of six feet per person should be postponed or cancelled.

The current event that this effects is the City Council meeting scheduled for March 17, 2020. Lemon Grove staff is closely monitoring the developments related to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) with San Diego County public health experts. The City continues to follow guidelines provided by the public health agencies at the county, state and federal level.

City of Lemon Grove staff are participating in regular briefings with public health officials and public safety agencies. At this time, residents are encouraged to stay informed and learn what you can do to protect your health, and prevent the spread of the virus.
