AMENDED NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF THE NOMINATION PERIOD GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION — TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2026

This Amended Notice supersedes the Notice of Extension of the Nomination Period dated August 7, 2026. It reflects the extension of the nomination period for all three (3) offices to be filled at the election and the close of the extended nomination period at 6:00 p.m.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a General Municipal Election will be held in the City of Lemon Grove on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the following offices:

- Two (2) Members of the City Council (At-Large) — full term of four (4) years
- One (1) Member of the City Council (At-Large) — short term of two (2) years

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the nomination period for the above offices opened on Monday, July 13, 2026 and closed on Friday, August 7, 2026 at 5:00 p.m.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Section 10225 of the California Elections Code, if nomination documents for an incumbent officer of the City are not filed by or on the eighty-eighth (88th) day before the election, during normal business hours as posted, the voters shall have until the eighty-third (83rd) day before the election, during normal business hours as posted, to nominate candidates other than the person who was the incumbent on the 88th day for that incumbent's elective office.

EXTENSION — CITY COUNCILMEMBER (FOUR-YEAR TERM)

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that **YADIRA ALTAMIRANO** and **JENNIFER MENDOZA**, the incumbents for the offices of City Councilmember (Four-Year Term), did not file nomination documents for those offices by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, August 7, 2026. Accordingly, the nomination period for the offices of City Councilmember (Four-Year Term) is extended to **Wednesday, August 12, 2026 at 6:00 p.m.** for persons other than the incumbents named above who are otherwise qualified to be nominated for those offices. The extended filing period is not available to the incumbents named above.

EXTENSION — CITY COUNCILMEMBER (TWO-YEAR SHORT TERM)

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that **SETH SMITH**, the appointed incumbent for the office of City Councilmember (Two-Year Short Term), did not file nomination documents for that office by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, August 7, 2026. Accordingly, the nomination period for the office of City Councilmember (Two-Year Short Term) is extended to **Wednesday, August 12, 2026 at 6:00 p.m.** for persons other than the incumbent named above who are otherwise qualified to be nominated for that office. The extended filing period is not available to the incumbent named above.

HOW TO OBTAIN AND FILE NOMINATION DOCUMENTS

Nomination documents are available and are being accepted for **both** the City Councilmember four-year seats and the City Councilmember two-year short-term seat. Documents are issued and accepted by the City Clerk at Lemon Grove City Hall, 3232 Main Street, Lemon Grove, California 91945. A prospective candidate may file for only one (1) office at this election.

Appointments are required. Because the extended deadline falls on the date of this Notice, prospective candidates are urged to contact the City Clerk immediately at (619) 825-3841 or jpablo@lemongrove.ca.gov. Walk-in service cannot be guaranteed.

All nomination documents must be filed with the City Clerk no later than 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 12, 2026. Documents received after that time cannot be accepted.
