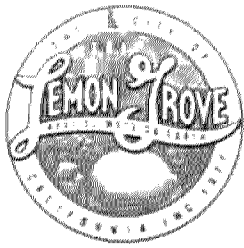

Summary:

The City Council created the CAC in September 2015 to act as a resident advisory/focus group to provide feedback to the City Council on a myriad of topics on an assignment-by-assignment basis. Each of the three commission positions will eventually serve a three-year term, but in the interim, staggered terms of one, two and three years will be offered to help ensure continuity on the Commission. Positions on the Commission are open to Lemon Grove residents. The Community Advisory Commission has a staff liaison designated to assist with the administrative work of the Commission and to serve as the key link with other City staff.

Background:

On September 15, 2015, the City Council adopted Ordinance 431 creating the Community Advisory Commission ("CAC"). The CAC is made up of three permanent members and a variable number of ad hoc or temporary members. The number and makeup of the temporary membership would change based upon the need for resident-members as determined on an issue-by-issue basis by the City Council. By resolution, the City Council can appoint additional members that serve for a limited duration (temporary) to assist the permanent members in the study of issues assigned to the CAC by the City Council. Limited duration members can be residents, business owners or property owners within the City.

The CAC's role is to serve as a resident-led Committee or Focus Group with the permanent members serving in the leadership positions for the Committee (i.e. Chair and Vice Chair of the overall committee.) The purpose would be to provide more stability to the Committee/Group with less reliance on staff to assume. The CAC will operate under the spirit of the Brown Act and comply with all public noticing and open meeting requirements. Permanent CAC members will be required to submit conflict of interest forms and complete ethics training.

Throughout the application period from December 21, 2016 – January 9, 2017, a total of 16 completed applications were received. A total of 14 interviews have been scheduled. One former candidate withdrew their application and one candidate serves in an incompatible office and withdrew his name for consideration. The CAC member position description (**Attachment A**) and the application (**Attachment B**) are included for City Council's reference.

June 13, 2017 Interview Process:

The steps below highlight the process for the June 13, 2017 special meeting:

- Conduct interviews;
 - Interviews have been scheduled to last approximately 10 minutes in length for each of the 14 candidates.
 - A list of proposed interview questions has been prepared, for your consideration (**Attachment C**).
- Deliberate on the selection of the three permanent CAC members;
- Direct staff as to which individuals should be appointed; and
- Staff will prepare a report for the June 20, 2017 City Council meeting for the formal appointment of permanent members to the Commission.

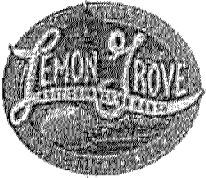

The practice of law is a second career for Ms. Kimber, who in 1984 began working in the area of social services and law enforcement in San Diego County. Ms. Kimber views her role as an attorney as an extension of her previous careers: an opportunity to help and assist others. Ms. Kimber has focused on the development and strengthening of tribal governments, including the development of tribal court systems, drafting and amending governmental organizing documents, intergovernmental agreements, tribal ordinances and regulations. Ms. Kimber has training and experience in the area of fee to trust applications, contract law and employment law, including the creation of employment policy and procedures manuals, and offering assistance and advice to human resources personnel in matters of workers compensation, disability, employment termination and medical leave. In addition to representing sovereign tribal governments, Ms. Kimber has represented tribal non-profit corporations and associations, and is familiar with issues related to federal contract funding.

Since 1994, Ms. Kimber has been extensively involved in gaming issues in California, Oregon and Washington. She has participated in the negotiation of several tribal-state compacts, as well as ongoing representation of tribes related to compact compliance and regulation. Ms. Kimber has exclusively represented California tribes since 1998.

Ms. Kimber's experience includes law and motion practice in both state and federal court proceedings, including trial and appellate practice. Ms. Kimber has participated in the drafting and negotiation of amendments to federal and state legislation. Of significance, Ms. Kimber assisted in the preparation of legislation in California that provided added protection for Native American sacred sites, legislation that fully funded the Indian Gaming Revenue Sharing Trust Fund, legislation that authorizes federally recognized tribes to enter into joint powers agreements with their neighboring local governments, and legislation related to the protection of traditional tribal fishing and gathering rights. Ms. Kimber has prepared testimony on behalf of tribal leaders for their appearances before various committees of the United States Congress, California Legislature and California administrative agencies and commissions, and has presented testimony on behalf of her clients before various committees of the California Legislature and California Administrative agencies and commissions. In addition to serving as legal counsel, Ms. Kimber has also served tribal clients in the areas of governmental affairs and communications. 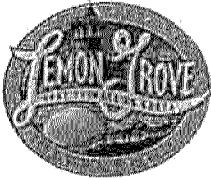

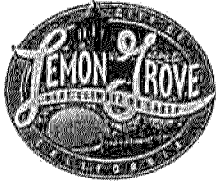
