Community driven initiatives such as Thrive often save communities money, improve our quality of life, and prepare our children for civic engagement and leadership, drive economic growth, and strengthen the fabric of our community.

Thrive Lemon Grove, a 501 (c)(3) non-profit organization, arose out of what originally began as a community garden in 2015. Thrive has since expanded its services to incorporate a monthly food giveaway, which provides consistent access to quality foods impacting as many as 3600 Lemon Grove residents. Food giveaways play a central role in mitigating food insecurity tackling an important and often hidden problem.

Latest endeavor

Recently, Thrive Lemon Grove has partnered with Project New Village bringing The Peoples Produce Mobile Farmer's Truck to Lemon Grove every Thursday. The Mobile Farmers Market can be located at VFW 2082, 2885 Lemon Grove Avenue, Lemon Grove, CA from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Beware of CYBER ROMANCE

If someone you have recently met online asks for your bank account information to deposit money, they are most likely using your account to carry out other schemes such as theft and fraud.
