3. Letter of Support to Renew the City of San Diego's Variance Request Tentative Order No. R9-2017-0007

Mike James reported that on November 1, 2016, District staff received a press release issued by the United States Environmental Protective Agency (EPA) regarding the City of San Diego's variance request to renew its variance from the secondary treatment requirements contained in section 301(b)(1)(B) of the Clean Water Act for the E. W. Blom Point Loma Metropolitan Wastewater Treatment Plant and Ocean Outfall.

Sanitation District staff prepared this agenda item to express the support for the variance request and for the City of San Diego's Pure Water program as outlined in the variance request submitted to the EPA in January of 2015. The letter was prepared with Boardmember Jones' signature because he is currently the Board's designated representative to the Metro Commission/Metro Wastewater Joint Powers Authority.

Public Speaker(s)

John L. Wood commented on the benefits to the City of San Diego with a pure water program.

Councilmember Vasquez disclosed that she is employed by the City of San Diego, but not for the Pure Water Program and asked the City Attorney for an opinion regarding her weighing in on this item.

James Lough answered Councilmember Vasquez's question and stated that this item doesn't affect her income, so there is no conflict..

4. Amended and Restated Joint Powers Agreement for Heartland Communications Facility Authority Agreement

Lydia Romero reported that the City of Lemon Grove is a member of the Heartland Communications Facility Authority, a joint powers authority (JPA) that provides fire and emergency medical dispatch services to member and contract agencies. The original agreement was entered into in 1986 and last amended in 2013.

The changes in the amended agreement were agreed to by the Management Advisory Committee and Board of Chiefs, and unanimously approved by the Heartland Communications Facility Commission at their meeting of November 3, 2016.

Ms. Romero noted that the most important elements of amended agreement are:

Member agencies are committing to a seven year term expiring June 30, 2023.

Introduction of a weighted voting system for "any CalPERS financial issue of the Authority."

The debt, liabilities, and obligations of the JPA are further defined. Withdrawing agencies are required to pay their pro rata share of all outstanding obligations.

To minimize the disproportionate administrative burden of small agencies, a minimum fee based on a threshold call volume (500 calls per year) will be assessed.

Clarification of quorum requirements to specify a majority of members, rather than those in attendance, is required for action.

Clarification of dissolution language to include "winding down" cost.

Discussion:

Each year, the City rotates its Mayor Pro Tem designee (Resolution No. 2649, adopted on July 16, 2006, establishes the rotation policy—Attachment C). During election years, Government Code Section 36801 states that following the declaration of election results and the installation of elected officials, the City Council chooses one of its members to serve as Mayor Pro Tem. During non-election years, the Mayor Pro Tem rotation occurs one year following the previous year's rotation.

The City's Mayor Pro Tem rotation policy is based on the three principles outlined below:

- 1. The rotation should follow the pattern established from the previous six years,
- 2. The Mayor Pro Tem should serve for approximately a one-year period, and
- In the event that two or more Councilmembers have not served as Mayor Pro Tem and have equal tenure in office, the one who received the most votes in the previous election should be placed higher on the rotation list.

The following City Councilmembers have rotated in the Mayor Pro Tem position in the following order for the past seven years: Jerry Jones (2010), Mary England (2011), George Gastil (2012), Howard Cook (2013), Jerry Jones (2014), and Racquel Vasquez (2015) and George Gastil (2016).

Based on the principles outlined in Resolution No. 2649, the following shows the rotation of Mayor Pro Tem for the next four terms:

December 2016 – December 2017 Jennifer Mendoza

December 2017 – December 2018 Jerry Jones

December 2018 – December 2019 David Arambula

December 2019 – December 2020 Matt Mendoza

It is recommended that Councilmember Jennifer Mendoza be appointed as the Mayor Pro Tem commencing on December 20, 2016 to serve in that position for the next year, followed by Councilmembers Jones and Arambula.

Conclusion:

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the resolution (**Attachment B**) appointing Councilmember Jennifer Mendoza as the Mayor Pro Tem from the period of December 20, 2016, 2016 through December 19, 2017 and confirm the rotation schedule for the subsequent three years.

WHEREAS, referring to the policy established by Resolution 2649, after a municipal election, the City Council is to appoint its Mayor Pro Tem and confirm the rotation for the subsequent two years by resolution; and

WHEREAS, applying the policy established by Resolution 2649, Councilmember Jennifer Mendoza would serve as Mayor Pro Tem for the period of December 20, 2016 through December 19, 2017, followed by Councilmember Jerry Jones, then by Councilmember David Aramubla, then by Councilmember Matt Mendoza in the subsequent three years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Lemon Grove, California hereby:

- 1. Appoints Councilmember Jennifer Mendoza as Mayor Pro Tem from December 20, 2016 through December 19, 2017; and

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEMON GROVE, CALIFORNIA, TO ESTABLISH THE POLICY FOR THE ROTATION OF MAYOR PRO TEM

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 36801 requires that during the City Council meeting at which the declaration of the election results for a General Municipal Election are made and, following the installation of elected officials, choose one of its number as Mayor Pro Tem; and

WHEREAS, if the Mayor is absent or unable to act, the Mayor Pro Tem shall serve until the Mayor returns or is able to act and the Mayor Pro Tem has all of the powers and duties of the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lemon Grove, California, hereby establishes the following policy:

- 1. After the certification of each municipal election (or regularly scheduled election) and at the seating of a new Mayor Pro Tem, the City Council shall review the Mayor Pro Tem rotation list for the next two years.
- 2. The Mayor Pro Tem should serve on a rotating basis so that each councilmember serves one (1) year as Mayor Pro Tem during his/her four (4) year term.
- 3. In the event of an occurrence that creates a disruption in the regular rotation of the Mayor Pro Tem, the Council shall consider the following principals in developing the rotation list:
 - a. The rotation history of the previous six years,
 - b. The Mayor Pro Tem serves for approximately a one-year period, and
 - c. In the event that two or more Councilmembers have not served as Mayor Pro Tem and have equal tenure in office, the one who received the most votes in the previous election should be placed higher on the rotation list.
- 4. Appointment of new Mayor Pro Tem and the rotation list for the next two years shall be done by resolution.

Background:

On December 1, 2015, the City Council awarded an agreement for the sanitation district rate study to NBS Government Finance Group (NBS). The intent of this study was to calculate a minimum equivalent dwelling unit fee for Sanitation District (District) users based on all anticipated district expenditures for a five year period.

Originally, NBS was expected to provide a five year rate study from Fiscal Year 2016/2017 to 2020/2021 before June 30, 2016. However, a number of external factors were revealed, discovered, and provided to District staff after the start of this rate study which prompted staff to recommend changes to the original agreement for the District Board (Board) to consider. Those factors are briefly listed below:

- Perform a connection fee analysis,
- Accelerated Pure Water program expenditures,
- Progress made on the Sewer System Master Plan update, and
- Review of applicable reserve funds to afford future uncertainties.

Due to the factors noted above, the District had to modify NBS' scope of services, with amendments, in order to research appropriate information, prepare applicable studies, and lastly, package the information into a final deliverable that the Board will use moving forward during the next five year period. Each amendment is summarized below:

- 1. Amendment No. 1: Approved on August 2, 2016, this amendment reduced the original scope of work while also including a connection fee analysis as a part of the five year rate study. This amendment reduced the agreement total to \$25,630.27 and maintained the term of the agreement through January 5, 2017.
- 2. Amendment No. 2: Approved on November 15, 2016, this amendment added work associated with noticing requirements to meet Proposition 218 as well as to attend and present the final rate study at two public meetings. This amendment increased the agreement total to \$43,405.27 and extended the agreement through June 30, 2017 in order to support the Proposition 218 process.

Discussion:

During the November 15th Board meeting, the Board requested that staff research and provide additional information to the Board in order to make the most informed decision available for the next five year rate study. Those additional study components include:

1. <u>Four Rate Increase Options</u>: Discuss the following four options to increase rates during the rate study and which one is the most beneficial to the District's users.

- a. Flat rate percentage increase for five years with a 40% district operational reserve level.
- b. Flat rate percentage increase for five years with a 55% district operational reserve level.
- c. Escalating rate structure increase for five years with a 40% district operational reserve level.
- d. Escalating rate structure increase for five years with a 55% district operational reserve level.
- 2. <u>Number, Amount, and Type of Cash Reserves</u>: Fully review the four reserve funds presented and explain the significance of each, how much each should equal, and why each fund should have a minimum amount on hand. As a summary for this report, there were four reserve funds:
 - a. Rate Stabilization Reserve: Includes one year's worth of costs to transport and treatment wastewater from the District.
 - b. *District Operational Reserve*: Unforeseen expenditures that the District may see as a result of its operations or maintenance.
 - c. Pure Water Reserve: Specific savings that will fund the Pure Water program and the accelerated costs required by the City of San Diego.
 - d. Capital Replacement Reserve: Funds set aside to afford to pay-as-you-go for all capital improvement projects.
- 3. <u>Duration</u>: The rate study should span five years from Fiscal Year 2017/18 thru FY 2021/22.
- 4. <u>Annual Capital Improvement Program (CIP)</u>: Using the most recent information from the Sewer System Master Plan update to program the latest capital improvement program needs in the next five year period.
- 5. <u>Return of Unallocated Reserves</u>: Any unallocated sanitation reserves should be returned to district rate users to lessen the burdened from the City of San Diego's accelerated Pure Water program.

In order to provide the most clarity and establish future expectations that the Board can anticipate moving forward, staff updated the rate study timeline and presented it below. Pending any unforeseen activities or Board requests to amend this timeline, staff will proceed with the actions listed below at each specific date.

•	December 20, 2016	Present Amendment No. 3 for approval.
•	February 7, 2017	NBS to present the connection fee study, full five year rate study, and deliverables from the all amendments to the Board.
•	February 21, 2017	Additional Board meeting if needed.
•	March 4, 2017	No later than date to provide Prop. 218 notices to the District users.
•	April 18, 2017	Board Meeting – Public hearing to introduce ordinance.
0	May 2, 2017	Board Meeting – Second reading and adoption of ordinance.
•	May 17, 2017	Additional Board meeting if needed.

June 2nd or 17th Rates approved via 30-days past the Ordinance adoption.

No sooner than July 1st the new rates will take effect. • July 1, 2017
